

97,000 take BITSAT-2011

HYDERABAD: The online examination of Birla Institute of Technology and Science and Special Aptitude Test (BITSAT-2011) for admissions into various institutes of BITS concluded successfully, a press release said. Close to 97,000 candidates appeared for the test, spread over four weeks between May and June.

Conducted across 25 centres in India, the online exam, which was conducted for the seventh consecutive year, is for admission to integrated first degree programmes for its BITS campuses in Pilani, Goa and Hyderabad.

The candidates who have appeared for the test should apply online giving programme preferences before 5 p.m., on June 30. The results of first iteration will be announced by July 1 and the entire admission process will be concluded by the first week of August at all the BITS campuses in India.
